



The Process

1. Fill out application form and NDA
 - a. ADISA will call and speak with you to qualify the requirements.
 - b. ASCDI will verify membership
2. You will be issued an “onboarding form” which will require you to share specific documents and share business processes with the ADISA Audit Team.
3. A desk top audit of those processes is carried out to ensure the paperwork and policies in place are compliant.
4. A formal site audit will be carried out by an ADISA Auditor including forensics on processed media. This typically takes 2 days.
5. A final report is issued with an award level based on your performance against the ADISA Standard. Any remediation is listed for you to be carried out.
6. You will then be classed as ASCDI / ADISA Certified and benefit from the following:
 - a. You will be given access to the ADISA learning portal and include the ADISA Certified Practitioner Courses for Technical, Compliance and Sales.
 - b. You will be given access to the ADISA members area including research, presentations, white papers and supporting information for your sales teams to use.
 - c. You will have a Certification Exploitation Plan agreed with ADISA (and ASCDI?) to help market your certification and to help drive business to you.
7. When you pass, you will receive:
 - a. An audit report for internal use detailing the findings of the audit and actions required.
 - b. A certified member’s statement. (for customer sharing).
 - c. A monitoring notice pack to allow your customers to sign up to a free of charge service to monitor your audit performance.
 - d. You will be given a company profile page for customers to see your level of certification
 - e. You may display the AscDiNatd ADISA certification logo
8. You will then be audited twice a year. These audits include physical site security checks, forensic checks, operation checks and customer compliance checks.
